

Terms of Use of the Free Trial Version of the FLIP Program

The use of the free trial version of the FLIP program is permitted only when the applicant agrees with the following regulations.

1. General

The following regulations are effective on the software programs, documents including manuals and key-files for execution provided by the General Incorporated Association FLIP Consortium as the free trial version of the FLIP program ("the FLIP trial version") and the user who applies for the FLIP trial version ("the user").

2. Permission of Use

The user receives the right of non-exclusive use of the FLIP trial version and the related manuals (only on the computer belonging to the user) for the permitted period of use (for the period of 6 months after the application). The user shall not transfer the FLIP trial version to a third party nor permit a third party to use the FLIP trial version.

3. Prohibition of Duplication

The user shall not make a duplicate of all or a part of the FLIP trial version.

4. Prohibition of Modification and Analysis

The user shall not make a modification on all or a part of the FLIP trial version. The user shall not analyze (decompile, disassemble or reverse engineering, etc.) the FLIP trial version.

5. Disclaimer

- (1) The FLIP trial version is provided "as is" without warranty of any kind, expressed or implied, as to its performance, accuracy or completeness. The FLIP Consortium makes no warranties, express or implied, concerning the FLIP trial version.
- (2) The FLIP Consortium disclaims all liability for direct, indirect or consequential damages resulting from the user's use of the FLIP trial version.
- (3) The FLIP Consortium disclaims all liability for direct, indirect or consequential damages resulting from the user's inability to use the FLIP trial version.
- (4) The FLIP Consortium makes no warranties, express or implied, that they are free of error, are consistent with any particular standard of merchantability or will meet the user's requirements for any particular application.

6. Revocation of Permission of Use

In the event of a breach by the user of this Terms of Use, the FLIP Consortium shall revoke the permission of use of the FLIP trial version.

7. Technical Support

The FLIP Consortium does not provide any technical support service for the FLIP trial version. The user shall not ask any kind of questions related to the FLIP trial version to the FLIP Consortium.

8. Operation Environment

The operation environment of the FLIP trial version is based on the original FLIP programs provided by the FLIP Consortium. The user shall check the operation environment of the FLIP trial version on the website of the FLIP Consortium.

- (2) The Tokyo District Court of Japan shall have exclusive jurisdiction to hear and settle any dispute under or in connection with this Terms of Use
